Through the unique guidance of his legendary grandfather, Shri Palghat Raghu, and as a disciple of Sangeetha Kala

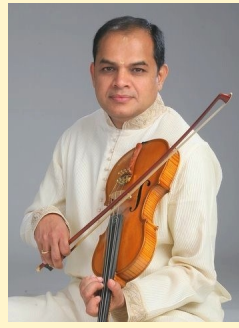
Acharya Shri P.S. Narayanaswamy, Abhishek Raghuram is emerging to be a defining contemporary vocalist.
